CLEANING GUIDE

Cleaning clear plexiglass (acrylic) requires careful handling to avoid scratching or damaging the surface.

Here are the recommended cleaning requirements:

1. Use a Soft Cloth

Always use a soft, non-abrasive cloth, such as a microfiber cloth, to prevent scratches.

2. Avoid Abrasive Cleaners

• Do not use harsh chemicals like ammonia-based cleaners (e.g., Windex) or abrasive cleaners, as they can cause clouding or surface damage.

3. Mild Soap and Water

- Mix a small amount of mild dish soap with warm water.
- Use a soft cloth to gently clean the surface.
- Rinse thoroughly with clean water to avoid leaving soap residue.

4. Specialized Acrylic Cleaners

- Use cleaners specifically designed for plexiglass, such as Novus Plastic Clean & Shine or Brillianize.
- These products clean without scratching and can also remove fine scratches.

5. Dry Gently

• Pat dry with a clean, soft cloth. Avoid rubbing, as it can create micro-scratches.

6. Avoid Harsh Tools

• Never use paper towels, scouring pads, or rough sponges, as they can scratch the surface.

7. Remove Stubborn Marks Carefully

• For grease or adhesive residue, use isopropyl alcohol (rubbing alcohol), applied with a soft cloth, followed by soap and water cleaning.

8. Dusting

• Use a feather duster or a clean, dry microfiber cloth to remove dust. Avoid using compressed air directly on the surface, as particles can scratch.

By following these steps, you can maintain the clarity and longevity of your plexiglass. Regular cleaning prevents buildup and ensures the surface stays in good condition.
